Acquisition (Buyout Program) Sell your home located in a flood zone to Haywood County.

Elevation Raise your home above floodwater levels.

Reconstruction Move or rebuild your home safely outside the flood zone.

Landslide Assistance A new program addressing landslide risks to homes and structures.
