The 2026-2027 Pavement Improvement Program has been divided into two parts. Part 1 is comprised of \$330,000 in proposed paving projects in the Town of Canton funded by Powell Bill allocations. Part 2 is an additional \$100,000 in paving projects which the Municipal Vehicle Tax will fund. The following is based on the current road conditions and can be amended if conditions change.
